Our group provides an opportunity for members to:

- Express and work through feelings of fear, frustration, worry, guilt, anger and other caregiver emotions.
- Assist family members in understanding the impact of the disease on family dynamics and develop realistic expectations of them selves and the person living with Alzheimer's or other dementias.
- Provide social contact for those who feel isolated because of their care responsibilities.
- Connect people with similar experiences so they support each other outside of meetings.
- Emphasize the importance of maintaining physical and mental health through respite and involvement in family life, work, community, social and recreational activities.

Caregivers are encouraged to attend alone so they can be open and honest about their personal situation.
