All water tests performed twice a month in numerous areas of our buildings over the past three months have found "no" evidence of the Legionella Bacteria. We will continue monthly water testing of numerous sites over the next three months and have paid a water consultant for a "Water Management Plan" that involves some testing, training, and procedures taken by our staff that should help ensure safe water for everyone now and in the future.
